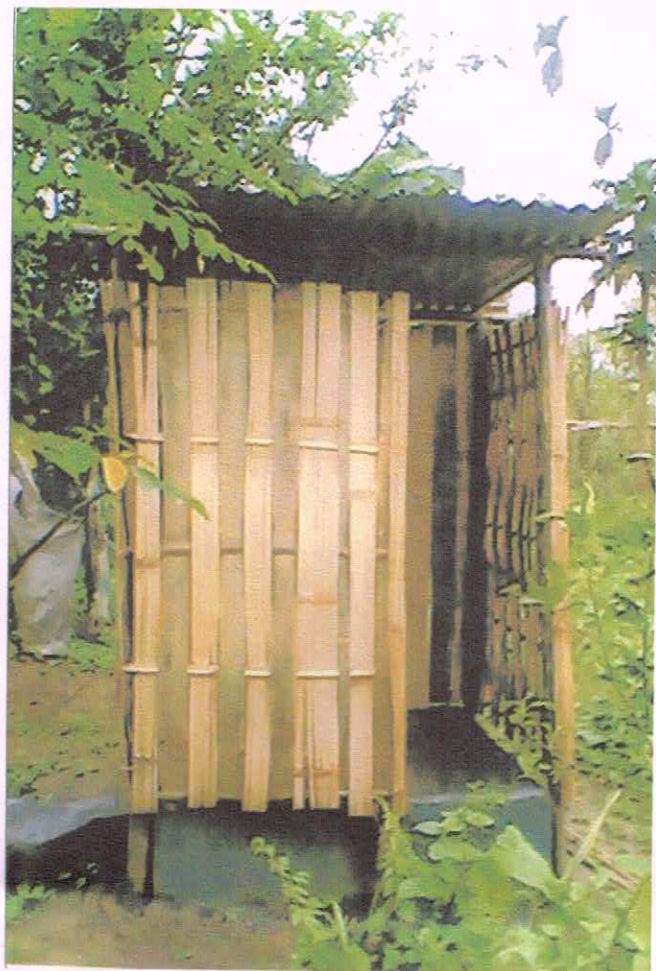

5. FLOOD RELIEF PROGRAMME:

The organization spent Raw Material, wages etc. for woodcraft Rs. 1,32,430/- (Rupees One Lac Thirty Two Thousand Four Hundred Thirty) only for the year 2012-2013

10. PERSONAL DEV. CAMP:

The main motto of the organization is overall development of the backward villagers and Tea Garden Peoples. It was decided by the executive body to arrange 3 days personal Dev. Camp for at least 100 youths. The arrangement of lodging, food and training Camp was arrange at Panchayati Raj Dharamsala, Tinsukia. The 3 days programme was successfully ended by the help of the well-wishers of Tinsukia. The organization collected donation of food, few cash money for great success of the camp. The organization totally spend Rs. 32,650/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Six Hundred Fifty) only For the year 2012-13.
